

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Reverend Faydith Ewers previously appeared before the Council with a number of her congregation and has requested permission to establish the Cibecue Apache Mission and construct a church, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Pat Cromwell has appeared before the Council and agreed to the use of land formerly assigned to him.

BE IT RESOLVED that area not to exceed one acre be granted to the Cibecue Apache Mission for construction of a church north of the present Cibecue Day School and west of the present LDS Mission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Superintendent are authorized to execute a revocable permit upon presentation of an adequate legal description to the office of the Superintendent, Fort Apache Indian Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
