

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, a number of people from McNary appeared before the Council several times requesting permission to construct an Assembly of God Church in the vicinity of McNary, and


WHEREAS, the Reverend Bert Parker has furnished a plat of an area northwest of McNary on the Sales Corral road requesting specific permission to build on this land.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of God Church of McNary, Arizona is hereby granted a revocable permit to construct a church in accordance with their request on the west side of the Sales Corral road northwest of McNary, 25 feet north of the townsite fence.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Assembly of God Church of McNary will provide an adequate description of the land to the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, and the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Superintendent are hereby authorized to issue a revocable permit for an area of approximately one-half acre.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
