
RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department has requested permission to develop another source of water as proposed by their geologist due to insufficient productive capacity of their present well.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Arizona Highway Department is hereby granted permission to develop another source of water at the Flying "V" Maintenance Camp; provided, they submit to the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency, a log of the well, including but without limitation to, all information relative to the pumping capacity of said well.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when the Arizona Highway Department relinquishes the land upon which the well is located that they leave said well thereon intact.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
