

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Payroll has increased from approximately 350 persons to over 1000 persons with the addition of the Neighborhood Youth Corps personnel, and

WHEREAS, it takes over four hours of employees time to sign the pay checks which time could be employed in other areas of more benefit to the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, there are devises on the market which could perform this function with adequate controls and provide at the same time metered postage and a savings in time utilization of approximately \$770.00 per year, and


WHEREAS, there are presently no technical reference works available in the field of accounting, personnel, and payroll and it would be advantageous to have these references available, and

WHEREAS, the estimated costs of these items is as follows:

Check register and postage meter	\$1200.00
Technical reference books	<u>224.00</u>
TOTAL	\$1424.00

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Budget be amended to add the sum of \$1424.00 for the purpose of purchasing the previously described items.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
