

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 64-105 was adopted by the White Mountain Apache Tribe to provide for an advance of \$25,100.00 of Tribal Treasury Funds for the construction of a building which upon completion was to be leased to the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise for use as a snack bar and canteen, and



WHEREAS, the Area Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs, has requested that if this building is still desired that the 1966 Budget be amended to include an appropriation of \$25,100.00 from Tribal Treasury Funds, and

WHEREAS, the Area Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs, has further stipulated that their approval of this resolution would be contingent upon approval of the plans, specifications and estimates of cost by the Area Office Branch of Plant Management; modification of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise's Plan of Operations to provide for management and operating capital as well as police officer control to be paid by the operating enterprise; and restriction of the use of the snack bar and canteen to persons twenty one years of age or older, and

WHEREAS, it is still the desire and wish of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to construct a building for the use of a snack bar and canteen at the earliest possible date.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$25,100.00 be advanced from Tribal Treasury Funds for the construction of a building to house a snack bar and canteen and that the stipulations previously described be complied with.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
