

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has made repeated requests to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to construct a municipal center in the Whiteriver, area, and

WHEREAS, we have been notified by Plant Design and Construction, Albuquerque, that funds are available for fiscal year 1966 for construction of the municipal center, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has agreed to an area of approximately two acres on the northeast corner of the old Fort Apache Wholesale Lumber Company millsite.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs be granted a 25-year lease with a 25-year option for the construction of the municipal center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and Area Director are hereby authorized to execute a lease in accordance with CFR 131 and Plant Design and Construction is to provide a legal description of the area to the office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that rights of way as needed for sewer, water and electrical distribution lines are also approved by this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
