

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Daniel and Mary Edwards on July 22, 1965, signed a document entitled "Termination of Lease by Mutual Agreement" on the following-described land: Homesite lease in the East Fork-Seven Mile Community in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T5N, R23E, a rectangular plot 208.7' east and west by 208.7' north and south located as follows: Beginning at the REA power pole by the East Fork Mission School Gymnasium and counting it #1, travel down the road in a southwesterly direction to pole #12, thence 157.9' in a southerly direction to the SW corner of the above plot; and

WHEREAS, Rencher and Theresa J. Paxson have applied for a homesite lease on the above tract; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has no objection to the use of this tract of land by Rencher and Theresa J. Paxson.

BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe do hereby approve and grant a homesite lease to Rencher and Theresa J. Paxson for a period of twenty-five (25) years at a rate of \$12.00 per year payable in advance on the first day of the month following the effective date of the lease with an annual payment of a like amount on the same date each year thereafter in accordance with the terms of the lease for as long as the lease shall run.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
