

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, has adopted the National Forest Log Scaling Handbook FSH 2443.71, US Forest Service, using the Scribner Decimal C log rule with modifications as may be approved by the Regional Forester, Region III, US Forest Service, and

WHEREAS, certain existing timber contracts recognize only the scaling procedure in Section 7 (c) of the Standard Timber Contract Provisions.

BE IT RESOLVED that in order to have uniformity in scaling methods, existing timber contracts may be modified by the deletion of Section 7 (c) as described above and that the National Forest Scaling Handbook with modifications as stated above be substituted in said Section 7 (c).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for the time being the Fort Apache Timber Company contract will remain as at present. Further consideration will be given on the Fort Apache Timber Company contract when the financial status of Fort Apache Timber Company shall become stable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no adjustments shall be made on all other contracts aforementioned, including the present contract with Southwest Forest Industries, Inc.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
