

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 65-104 granted Western States Telephone Company permission to construct a telephone line to McKays Peak, and

WHEREAS, Navopache Electric Co-operative, Inc. has requested permission to construct a power line to McKays Peak by using the poles of Western States Telephone Company under their Joint Use Agreement.

BE IT RESOLVED that Navopache Electric Co-operative, Inc. is hereby granted permission to construct a power distribution line to the McKays Peak Area, approximately 2.7 miles in length, under their Joint Use Agreement with Western States Telephone Company.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
