

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Jack Fowler dba Broken Arrow Cafe has a traders license and a Tribal Lease covering the premises commonly known as Broken Arrow Cafe, and

WHEREAS, he has been in the past, delinquent in quarterly payments, estimated percentage payments and in his yearly lease fee payments, and

WHEREAS, he is now in default of his lease.

BE IT RESOLVED that Jack Fowler dba Broken Arrow Cafe is hereby given five days from September 7th to make all payments of the Tribal Lease current.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if said payments are not make current within said period, that his lease shall be terminated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if he does not make further payments within five days after receipt of notice of his delinquency his lease will likewise be terminated.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
