RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on occasion the Tribal Attorney needs to use private chartered airplanes for tribal business, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney's contract does provide for reimbursement of travel expenses when using privately chartered planes.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney's Contract is hereby amended to provide that when the Tribal Attorney deems it necessary and when on tribal business he may use private chartered airplanes and be reimbursed for the actual cost of said airplane fare.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (d) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
