

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the forecasted volume of sales in the concrete and related fields upon which the Plan of Operations of the White Mountain Concrete and Gravel Enterprise was based has failed to materialize, and

WHEREAS, work in the field of general construction is available and would be of benefit to the Tribe directly as well as the individual Tribal members who are employed in the Enterprise individually, and

WHEREAS, it appears that adequate controls through the Superintendent, Fort Apache Agency are incorporated in the attached amendment to the Plan of Operations of the White Mountain Concrete and Gravel Enterprise.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached amendment be made a part of and replace that section of the Plan of Operations of the White Mountain Concrete and Gravel Enterprise captioned "Latitude of Operations."

The foregoing resolution was on September 16, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
