
RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, several Council members questioned the keeping of proper records and the depository of Community Development Club funds in the various communities, and

WHEREAS, these clubs are chartered under the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe through the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council and the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency are hereby requested to provide one auditor each to carry out annual audits on all accounts and records of all community development associations on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation. These audits will be performed jointly by the two aforementioned auditors.

The foregoing resolution was on September 16, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
