

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, D. T. Stevens desires to sell the Trading Post commonly known as Canyon Inn, and

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Edward Troy of Mesa, Arizona desire to buy same, and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that Mr. and Mrs. Edward Troy would operate the business efficiently.

BE IT RESOLVED that the transfer of the tribal lease, covering the lands and the assignment by D. T. Stevens to Mr. and Mrs. Edward Troy, is hereby approved and consented to.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the issuance of an Indian Traders license to Mr. and Mrs. Edward Troy is also approved.

The foregoing resolution was on October 27, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
