

Resolution No. 65-148

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there are many eligible tribal members who are in need of borrowing money from the Revolving Credit, and

WHEREAS, the Construction Enterprise owes the Revolving Credit, \$90,000.00, and

WHEREAS, it will cost approximately \$10,000.00 to construct and install a water system to the construction site of the canteen, and

WHEREAS, additional funds are needed for public relations.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury the sum of \$90,000.00 to pay the Revolving Credit, which sum is owed Revolving Credit by the Construction Enterprise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury the sum of \$10,000.00 to be used to construct a water system to the new canteen site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Budget is amended by appropriating the sum of \$3,000.00 on deposit in the U. S. Treasury, said sum to be added to the public relations fund.

The foregoing resolution was on October 27, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
