

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Employment Office desires to construct a new office building, and

WHEREAS, it would be an advantage to the Tribe to have the office building in close proximity to the Tribal Office.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized to sign a 25 year gratuitous lease with the Arizona State Employment Service covering a parcel of land north of the present Tribal Business Office, said site to be approved by the Chairman and Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the new office building design and construction be similar, as nearly as possible, to the design and construction of the Tribal Business Office.

The foregoing resolution was on October 27, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
