

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Coulter No. 3 Logging Unit contract, Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., purchaser, approved July 23, 1965, by the Area Director, specified that the minimum annual cut for the calendar year 1965 was 5,000,000 board feet, and


WHEREAS, the purchaser has requested relief from the minimum cutting volume for 1965, and


WHEREAS, the purchaser operations were shut down due to a strike lasting forty-five operating days and has encountered problems resulting in low production, and

WHEREAS, the purchaser will continue cutting on the unit until bad weather closes operations, but will be unable to meet the minimum annual cutting requirement for 1965.

BE IT RESOLVED that the purchaser be granted relief from the 5,000,000 board feet minimum annual cut for 1965, and that all other terms of the contract remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
