

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, \$2,500.00 was appropriated in the Tribal Budget for the 1965-66 Fiscal Year to pay commercial audit expenses, and

WHEREAS, the condition of the Central Tribal books at the time of the audit was such that an unusual amount of audit time was required to complete the audit thereby incurring costs above that budgeted, and

WHEREAS, the bill from the auditors, Williams and Company, exceeded the budget by \$2,181.70 which amount has not been paid and the services therefore have been rendered.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$2,181.70 be advanced from Tribal Treasury Funds to pay this indebtedness to Williams and Company.

The foregoing resolution was on November 10, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
