

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Jump-Off No. 2 Logging Contract, Reidhead-Chlarson Logging Company, purchaser, approved February 20, 1964, required all obligations to be completed December 31, 1965, and

WHEREAS, due to adverse weather conditions which prevented the completion of slash burning, and

WHEREAS, the Agency Forestry Department has recommended an extension of time to complete contract.

BE IT RESOLVED that a time extension be granted to the contractor that all slash be burned and completed on December 31, 1966.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
