

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads is prohibited by Title 25 Code of Federal Regulations from maintaining roads on the reservation which are not a part of the Bureau Road System, and

WHEREAS, recreational usage of some of the roads on the reservation not on the Bureau system has grown to the point that at least minimal maintenance is required.

BE IT RESOLVED that the following list of reservation roads be added to the Bureau road system on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
