

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Alchesay Hall is in need of repairs and alterations, and

WHEREAS, by spending a small sum of money for said repair and alterations a fire hazard can be eliminated and the gymnasium could seat an additional three hundred (300) people, and


WHEREAS, at any athletic functions, tribal members are refused admittance because of the lack of space.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds the sum of \$1500.00 to defray partial cost of said repairs and alterations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Athletic Director is hereby authorized to spend an additional sum not to exceed \$1500.00 from athletic receipts to pay the balance of the cost of repairs and alterations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$1500.00 appropriated from tribal funds be paid from savings made from other items in the tribal budget.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
