

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 65-20 the Tribe leased to the Bureau of Indian Affairs a certain area of ground to Cibecue to construct a new school thereon, and

WHEREAS, the map of said area is on file at Fort Apache Agency, Whiteriver, and


WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has requested additional land on which to construct a lagoon, pipeline and storage tank, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe will benefit by the construction of said school.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized and directed to sign an addendum to the Cibecue School lease said addendum providing the leasing of approximately 12.8 acres of ground to be used for a lagoon, pipeline and storage tank, the plant of said additional land being on file at the Fort Apache Agency Office and to which reference is hereby made.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said addendum provide that if at any time the Bureau of Indian Affairs fails to use the aforementioned site for educational purposes, the lease shall terminate.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
