

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe has entered into agreement with the State Livestock and Sanitary Board to match the salary which they pay their representative on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the State Livestock and Sanitary Board on July 1, 1965 raised their portion of the salary to \$2400.00 per year and the Tribe is paying \$1934.40 per year, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to match the state payment retroactive to July 1, 1965.

BE IT RESOLVED that the State Representative, Mr. Steven Lupe, be paid the sum of \$236.41 as retroactive back pay for the period 1 July through 31 December, 1965 and that the sum of \$152.23 be appropriated for the remainder of the fiscal year and that the sum of \$39.00 be appropriated for payroll taxes, making a grand total of \$427.64 to be appropriated from Tribal Funds on deposit with the United States Government.

The foregoing resolution was on January 5, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
