WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has completed two new impoundments,
and


WHEREAS, the Recreation Enterprise has been charged with the responsibility
of managing these new impoundments for recreational and income
purposes, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors has made
recommendations regarding the management and naming of the new lakes.


BE IT RESOLVED that the impoundment located on Largo Creek be named Bootleg
Lake and be opened to public fishing on May 1, 1966.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the impoundment on Moon Creek be named Christmas
Tree Lake and that it be managed for the propagation of the Apache
Native Trout.

The foregoing resolution was on January 13, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10
for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,
pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended
Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
