WHEREAS, the Tribe is now in litigation with the Salt River Water Users Association regarding the building of recreation lakes on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Salt River Water Users Association has and will spend great sums of money to publicize its side of the controversy, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe needs to let the general public know the White Mountain Apache recreational water story.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman, Tribal Attorney, William Glidden and Neal Hall are hereby authorized and instructed to negotiate with public relations firms and to recommend to the Tribe the most competent firm and the cost therefore to publicize the White Mountain Apache water story.

The foregoing resolution was on January 25, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
