

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Assembly of God Church has helped develop the spiritual and moral fiber of the Apaches, and

WHEREAS, the Cedar Creek Assembly of God Church has requested a revocable permit of a parcel of ground approximately one mile in an easterly and westerly direction by 150 feet graduated to 300 feet in a northerly and southerly direction, Lower Cedar Creek contiguous to the old rodeo ground to be used as a revival camp site and parking area, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal members will benefit by the establishment of said area for said use.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent and the Chairman are hereby requested to issue a revocable permit to the Cedar Creek Assembly of God Church to be used for religious purposes.

The foregoing resolution was on March 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
