

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency has been advised by the Phoenix Area Office Branch of Education that indications are that Summer Program Funds from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, which have been available to help sponsor Youth Camps in years past, will not be available this fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, we feel that Summer Youth Camp Programs for our school children have been the most successful and beneficial programs for our youngsters that we have ever conducted, and

WHEREAS, there is a possibility that assistance for this Summer Youth Camp Program may be forthcoming from the Community Action Program of the Office of Economic Opportunity if application is made thereto.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Community Action Director and staff advisors be requested to make application to the Office of Economic Opportunity for such assistance, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be authorized and directed to sign whatever documents are necessary in connection therewith.

The foregoing resolution was on March 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
