

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Gus Quintero has applied for a tribal loan of \$7,000.00 for home construction, and

WHEREAS, the loan application requires Council recommendation for approval because Gus Quintero is a member of the Credit Committee for the Revolving Credit Program, and

WHEREAS, a homesite lease is required by Section 23 (e) II of the Declaration of Policies and Plan of Operation approved January 19, 1961, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has no objection to the use of the land by this individual.


BE IT RESOLVED that the loan application be recommended for approval in the amount of \$7,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe do hereby approve and grant a homesite lease to Gus Quintero for a period of twenty-five (25) years at the rate of \$12.00 per year payable annually in advance on the first day of the month following the effective date of the lease with annual payments of like amount on the same date each year thereafter in accordance with the term of the lease for as long as the lease is in effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman shall execute said lease for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in accordance with Tribal Ordinance No. 44; the effective date of the commencement of said lease being the date of the approval of the loan by the Secretary of the Interior or his designated representative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the loan not be approved within ninety (90) days from the date hereof, the lease shall thereby automatically terminate.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
