WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, there is \$90,000.00 available in the Revolving Credit Loan Fund for relending to Enterprises, and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise needs \$90,000.00 to construct ten (10) additional motel units and a restaurant in the Hon-Dah complex, and

WHEREAS, studies reveal this development is economically feasible.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is hereby authorized and directed to request a modification to the Enterprise Application and Agreement of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise to permit the advance of an additional \$90,000.00 to said enterprise for the construction of ten (10) motel units and a restaurant in the Hon-Dah complex; that the Chairman is further authorized to execute all necessary documents as may be required by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs or his duly authorized representative.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
