

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the newly elected Tribal Chairman is in need of quarters, and

WHEREAS, the house now occupied by Mr. Paul Simmons has been previously occupied by the Tribal Chairman.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this house is hereby set aside for the Chairman of the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the Chairman of the Tribal Council desire to live in other quarters, this house may be occupied by others than the Tribal Chairman with the occupant advised that it may be necessary for him to vacate the quarters on a two-week notice.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
