

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Col. George S. Kilpatrick has a lease with the Tribe on Lot No. A-81, Smith Park Recreation area, and

WHEREAS, Col. Kilpatrick owes the Tribe the approximate sum of \$7500.00, and

WHEREAS, he has a loan with the R & S Investment Corporation in the approximate amount of \$6,000.00 secured by a chattel mortgage of the cabin located on said lot, and

WHEREAS, he desires to borrow sufficient funds from the First National Bank of Arizona to pay the indebtedness owed the Tribe together with the indebtedness of R & S Investment Corporation, and

WHEREAS, the cabin has been appraised in the amount of \$21,600.00 by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Real Estate Appraisals.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary for and on behalf of the Tribe is authorized to guarantee a loan by Col. George S. Kilpatrick to the First National Bank in a sum not to exceed \$15,000.00.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a second mortgage be executed in favor of the White Mountain Apache Tribe on the dwelling.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby appropriates and sets aside the sum of \$15,000.00 to secure payment in case of default by Col. George S. Kilpatrick.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
