

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is an unchartered organization operating under the Indian Re-organization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended by the Act of June 15, 1935 (49 Stat. 378) and operating under the provisions of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe approved by the Secretary of the Interior May 29, 1958 and adopted by the White Mountain Apache Tribal voters June 27, 1958, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is authorized to borrow money and to pledge future tribal income under the provisions of Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws, and
- WHEREAS, Resolution of the Tribal Council No. 64-133 approved Modification No. 5, Section No. 2 of Contract No. 14-20-450-3804 extending the loan contract to January 1, 1967.
- WHEREAS, there is an unadvanced amount under said contract of \$1,587,080.00 and
- WHEREAS, there is an immediate need for \$200,000.00 for housing loans to tribal members unable to obtain financing elsewhere.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is hereby authorized and directed to request an advance of \$200,000.00 for the White Mountain Apache Revolving Credit Loan Program under Contract No. 14-20-450-3804, and to execute all necessary documents in connection with the advance.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$200,000.00 is to be used for regular loans to individuals.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
