

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department is now repairing and maintaining State Highway 73 between Whiteriver and Carrizo Junction, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal members will benefit by the improvement of the road, and

WHEREAS, the said Highway department desires to be donated free cinders that are placed on said road.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent and the Chairman are hereby authorized to give, without charge, the necessary cinders from the Cooley Mountain Cinder Pit to the Arizona Highway Department solely for use on State Highway 73 between Whiteriver and Carrizo Junction.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
