

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has an existing cooperative agreement with the Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife Service, providing for fishery management services on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Service has provided valuable assistance to the Tribe for many years, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has requested big game and wildlife management assistance from the Service, and


WHEREAS, the Service has agreed to furnish such services.

BE IT RESOLVED that the agreement on file in the office of the Superintendent, Fort Apache Indian Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona between the Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife of the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Department of the Interior and the White Mountain Apache Tribe be approved,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized to sign the Agreement for and on behalf of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
