

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there has been a request to advertise for a public sale oil and gas leases covering lands in Townships 9, 10 and 11 North, Range 17 thru 22 on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, said area contains approximately 177,280 acres, and

WHEREAS, it would be advantageous to the White Mountain Apache Tribe to lease said lands.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Phoenix Area Director of the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby requested to advertise for public sale oil and gas leases in Townships 9, 10 and 11, Range 17 thru 22, Navajo County, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arizona, as soon as possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the U. S. Geological Survey be requested to make a determination as to whether or not the area under lease to the Colorado Fuel and Iron Corporation should be excluded from the area to be advertised.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Secretary is further authorized to issue exploration permits when he deems it to be to the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
