

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Health and Accident Insurer of the Guardian Life Insurance Company, and

WHEREAS, the Council feels that the rates charged by the insurer are too high and the services inadequate.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Administrative Manager is hereby directed to negotiate with any and all insurance companies and to recommend to the Tribal Council a new group insurance carrier that will charge the lowest and provide the best service to the employees of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
