

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribe on the first day of March, 1961 pursuant to Lease No. SA73ph-949 leased to the U. S. Public Health Service the community building located on the Cibecue community grounds for a monthly rental of thirty dollars (\$30.00), and

WHEREAS, Paragraph 5 of said lease provides that the lessee can renew said lease on a year to year basis not to exceed a term beyond the first day of March, 1971, and

WHEREAS, the lessee has noticed the Tribe that it wishes to renew the lease for an additional year i.e. from the first day of March, 1966 to the first day of March, 1967.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to enter into a year's lease renewal agreement with the U. S. Public Health Service covering the Community Building at Cibecue pursuant to the said lease now in existence between the Tribe and the U. S. Public Health Service.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
