

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, as part of the Branch of Land Operations Recreation Lake Development, two new lakes on the Bog Creek drainage are being developed, and the existing Wilson Lake is being enlarged, and

WHEREAS, approximately 500,000 board feet of timber lies within the proposed lake sites area and should be harvested.

BE IT RESOLVED that the timber in the Bog Creek Logging Unit, consisting of the areas outlined above, be appraised and sold to the highest bidder at not less than the following stumpage rates gross tree scale:

Ponderosa pine	\$13.75 per M. Bd. Ft.
Douglas-fir	14.10 per M. Bd. Ft.
Spruce & Other Species	8.10 per M. Bd. Ft.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are authorized to execute the contract and related documents necessary to administer the sale of this timber for and on behalf of this Council.

The foregoing resolution was on June 17, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
