

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Guardian Life Insurance Company has a contract with the Tribe insuring the tribal employees for health and accident, and

WHEREAS, the Connecticut Life Insurance Company has offered the Tribe a new insurance contract which would have broader and better coverage at a lesser premium.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby directed to terminate the tribal group health and accident insurance contract with the Guardian Life Insurance Company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a new health and accident insurance contract for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe with the Connecticut Life Insurance Company, said new contract having been fully explained to the Tribal Council by Mr. Neal Hall, Administrative Manager of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on June 17, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
