

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, a six mile base and penetration contract on the Cibecue Road has been entered into between the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Tiffany Construction Company, and

WHEREAS, approximately 54,100 tons of screenings at an appraised value of \$8,115.00 will be used on said road, and

WHEREAS, these screenings will be produced on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to waive any charges therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe hereby waives any charge for 54,100 tons of screenings to be used on said Cibecue road by the Tiffany Construction Company.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$8,115.00 saved by donating these materials shall be used on the roads of the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
