WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. provides electrical service on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, it will be necessary in the future to extend this service to vast areas of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation at a tremendous installation cost, and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary for Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. to borrow funds to construct these lines, and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a Federal Bank for rural electric systems would be a great aid to Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. in securing these funds.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe unanimously endorses HB 14000 which in effect would establish a Federal Bank for rural electric systems.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
