RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by Resolution No. 66-88 passed June 17, 1966 approved the Bog Creek Logging Unit for sale, and

WHEREAS, after a fifteen-day advertising period, no bids received on this sale, and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company has agreed to purchase this sale, however, they have requested that the contract expiration date be extended from August 1, 1966 to September 1, 1966, and

WHEREAS, due to the delay in receiving a bid on this timber and the possible loss of revenue to the Tribe if this timber is not removed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the contract expiration date be extended to September 1, 1966.

The foregoing resolution was on July 19, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
