FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has an active game management program, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Game Management Section has conducted surveys and proposed game seasons and bag limits to harvest surplus game animals, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors has recommended that the proposed hunting regulations be adopted.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached hunting regulations, seasons and bag limits be approved for members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the 1966-1967 hunting seasons.

The foregoing resolution was on July 19, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
