WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apaches have developed many beautiful recreational facilities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apaches, in order to develop these facilities, had to face tremendous legal odds, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe through these legal controversies has learned that there is a dire need for additional water in Central Arizona.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council unanimously endorses H. R. 4671, commonly known as the Lower Colorado River Basin Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is directed to send a letter of endorsement to all members of the House of Representatives of the U. S. Congress.

The foregoing resolution was on July 19, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
