WHEREAS, Steven Lupe has applied for a Tribal Loan of \$4,000.00 for the purchase of cattle, and

WHEREAS, the loan application requires Council recommendation for approval because Steven Lupe is a member of the Credit Committee for the Revolving Credit Program, and


WHEREAS, Steven Lupe has an approved Tribal Land Assignment of 20 acres more or less, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has no objection to the use of the land for grazing purposes by this individual, and

WHEREAS, Steven Lupe has had considerable experience in the cattle business.

BE IT RESOLVED that the loan application be recommended for approval in the amount of \$4,000.00.

The foregoing resolution was on July 19, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
