FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors has made recommendations for the harvest of surplus game animals by non-members, and


WHEREAS, the sale of hunting permits is an important source of income to support the tribal game management and law enforcement program, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Game And Fish Commission has approved the season dates, bag limits and permit structure requested by the Tribe for non-members.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached regulations for non-member hunting be approved for the 1966-67 hunting seasons.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
