WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to produce a 16 mm color movie showing tribal cultural, historical, scenic and other attractions on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the said movie will include Tribal Enterprise activities and resource developments, and


WHEREAS, the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service has offered to cooperate with the Tribe in the production of the movie.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe pledges \$3,000.00 as its share of the cost of production, payable upon completion of the movie.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the General Tribe, White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, Fort Apache Timber Company and Tribal Livestock activities are instructed to amend their budgets to provide \$750.00 each for this project.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
