

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the restriction of the hours of holding Revival Meetings is a violation of the Freedom of Religion section of the Constitution of the United States, and

WHEREAS, certain church groups have complained about the restriction.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 63-10 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on August 3, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
