


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that an additional emergency fund in the amount of \$2,000.00 will be needed to furnish entertainment and other expenses for the annual White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair, and

WHEREAS, this annual function is one of the most important one for a great number of Apaches.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$2,000.00 from Tribal funds on deposit with the Treasurer of the United States Government to be used as needed for many expenses for putting on the fair.

The foregoing resolution was on September 7, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
