FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribe is now a member of the National Congress of American Indians, and


WHEREAS, this national organization has always assisted the Tribe in its many problems.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$177.50 from the Tribe's funds on deposit with the Treasurer of the United States Government to pay the 1966-67 annual National Congress of American Indians' Association dues.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that from said funds on deposit there is hereby donated an additional sum of \$200.00 for use of the said National Congress of American Indians' Association.

The foregoing resolution was on September 7, 1966 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
